Eligibility

Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. All small dogs will be wicketed. Veteran dogs (over 7 years of age) may run two thirds of the normal course distance at the owner's discretion. Handler must declare prior to the start of the dog's run which distance the dog will run. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.) More information can be found at: http://www.akc.org/events/coursing_ability_test/

Dogs run singularly.

Distance and Time

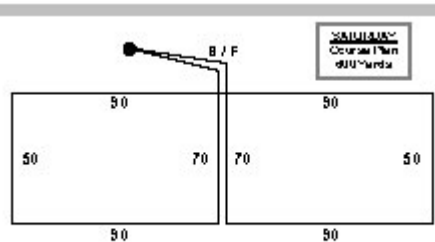
300 Yard Course. This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. A dog must complete this course in less than 1½ minutes.

600 Yard Course. This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300 yard course. A dog must complete this course in less than 2 minutes.

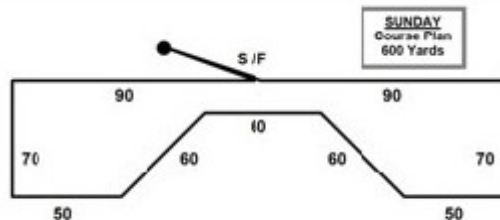
If there is a question which course a dog should run, the judge will decide. The dog must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Conditions of Entry

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial
- Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period; entry fees will not be refunded
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be refused entry and if present at inspection, entry will be refunded.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any handler not cleaning up after their dog.
- There will be a minimum \$25 returned check charge
- Courses will be 600 yards or 300 yards depending on the size and or breed of dog
- Battery or continuous loop machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judge, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine and on the field
- Back-up equipment will be available
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Any decisions made by the event's officiating judge(s) regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the judge(s) to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Judge(s) is responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.
- GPDC and Tri-State Sighthound Club reserves the right to alter the course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the trial
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds by the Test Committee.
- Children MUST be under control by their parents or guardians at all times
- At its discretion, GPDC, may break periodically during the day to accommodate judge and worker ring times and lunch.

HOW TO ENTER

Complete an official AKC entry form for each dog and either mail your entries and entry fee to the Event Secretary (see address on page 2 of premium list) or turn your entries in at the Event Secretary's desk on the field before the close of entries. Be sure to include the entry fee. **Make checks payable to "GPDC".**

Each dog may only enter once per test. Enter early, as only 60 entries per event will be accepted for each test. Any dog can be registered with the AKC. If your dogs need to be registered, you can do so online at http://akc.org/canine_partners/ or by completing the Canine Partner Enrollment Application. If the latter, submit the enrollment application, along with the enrollment fees, at the time of entry to the Event Secretary. Note that Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.

You may also enter early by mailing all forms and fees to the Event Secretary, so that it is received by the closing date and time for early entries. If your dog becomes lame, sick or in season prior to the test, do not bring the dog to the test. Instead, contact the Event Secretary to cancel your entry and your entry fee will be destroyed or otherwise refunded. Entering early is advised as each test is limited to 60 entries per event.

Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form. Follow your veterinarian's recommendations to assure that your dogs are free of parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public emergency, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

The Event Secretary must have the completed entry form and payment before a dog may be presented for inspection.

ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION

All dogs must be presented for inspection without tape, bandages, wrapping, or coverings of any kind (e.g., coats and blankets). At least two persons from the Test Committee will inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete, and female estrus (in season). In their opinion, any entered dog that is found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season will not be allowed to run. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are old, have breathing or heart problems, are overweight, or are out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The entry fee will be refunded for any dog that is not allowed to run by the inspectors.

Roll call and inspection will run continuously. Any dog that fails to present for inspection prior to the close of roll call and inspection will be marked absent. No refund will be given for an absent dog.

PADDOCK

We will begin running courses as soon as roll call and inspection begin. Dogs may run wearing a close fitting buckle collar. Choke collars and collars with dangling decoration will not be allowed. Hanging collar tags may be permitted if they are secured tightly to the collar, such as by tape. Slip leads can be used if the owner desires.

A run order will be established for all pre-entered dogs. Worker and volunteer dogs will run first. The Paddock Master will line up dogs according to the run order. Day of test entries will run at the end of the established run order.

If a dog is not present when it is called to run its test, the dog's name will be moved to the end of the running order. After roll call and inspection closes, any entered dog that has not yet tested and is not present within 5 minutes of completion of the last course will be marked absent and no refund will be given.

WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS THE C.A.T.? The Coursing Ability Test (C.A.T.) is a pass/fail test. In order to pass, the dog must chase the plastic lure, and complete the course one time, by himself, with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance. **If there is a question which course a dog should run, the judge will decide.**

DOGS LESS THAN 12" TALL & "FLAT FACED" DOGS. Any entrant that is less than 12" tall at the withers and/or brachycephalic (bulldog) will run a clearly marked 300-yard course that is basically rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 300-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 1 ½ minutes.

DOGS MORE THAN 12" TALL. Any entrant that is taller than 12" at the withers and not brachycephalic shall run a clearly marked 600-yard course (or as close to 600 yards as possible) that is basically rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 600-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 2 minutes.

CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR COURSING ABILITY? Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times. These are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower level title.

Coursing Ability (CA) – Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test three times under at least two different judges.

Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 10 times

Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 25 times.

Brachycephalic Dogs

If you have a question about whether or not your breed is considered Brachycephalic or not, please check with your AKC parent club for your breed.

Interstate 90, Exit #235, Rte 193 Kingsville. Go south on Rte 193, 2-3 miles to Plymouth-Gageville Road. Turn right (west), go 1.9 miles to Maple Road. Go 0.3 miles to entrance on left. Fischer's Pine Lake Park.

From the South:

Rte 11 to Rte 167, turn right (east) onto Rte 167; go 1.3 miles to Brown Road. Turn left onto Brown Road. Go 3.2 miles to Griggs Road, turn right. Go 0.8 miles to Maple Road, turn left. Go 2.8 miles to test site on the right. Fischer's Pine Lake Park.

General Site Descriptions: The field is fenced with typical farm fencing. The weather may be hot, and field conditions vary from wet and muddy, through ice/snow. Please provide your own shade and water for your hounds.
